Additional Pumford Employees Receive LEED Accreditation

Over the past week, four more of Pumford Construction's employees became Leadership in Energy and Efficiency Design Accredited Professionals (LEED APs):

- Greg Turner, LEED AP; Vice President with Pumford since 1997
- James Jacobs, EIT, LEED AP; Project Manager & Estimator with Pumford since 2007
- Chris Bohinski, LEED AP; Architectural Technician with Pumford since 2006
- Jason Reinbold, LEED AP; Architectural Technician with Pumford since 2001

The above four join Brian Swedorski, AIA, LEED AP, on Pumford Construction's expanding list of LEED APs. All of these professionals have demonstrated the understanding of the Green Building Rating system and how to apply its techniques to the construction industry. Because of their high degree of knowledge, they are each capable of guiding a project through the LEED Certification Process.

Within the past year, Pumford Construction has been fortunate enough to design and construct two LEED projects in Michigan. The first was completed in August 2008 for Consumers Energy for their Marshall Training Center facility. This was the first LEED Certified project for both Consumers Energy and Pumford Construction. The second project, located in Bay City, was designed and built for the developing company Provisions, and tenants - the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and the Department of Energy, Labor and Economic Growth (DeLEG). It is expected to be officially certified within the next month and receive a gold rating, the second highest rating in the U.S. Green Building Council's scale. An Earth Day open house is to be held for the public on Wednesday, April 22nd. All of the above stated Pumford employees gained experience and contributed to both projects.
